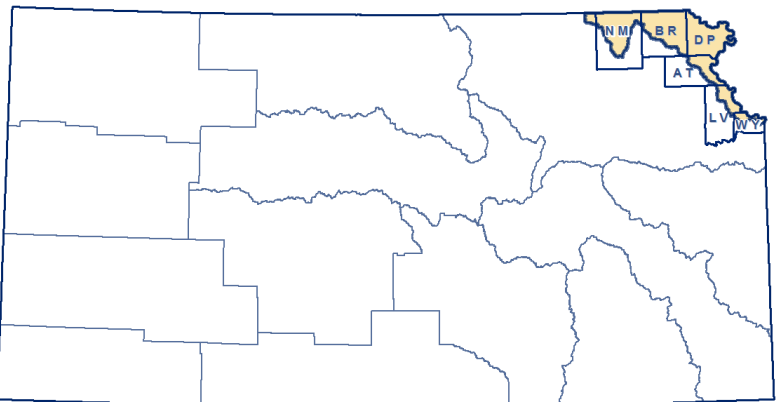

CURRENT FOCUS AREA

Size: 1,466 sq miles

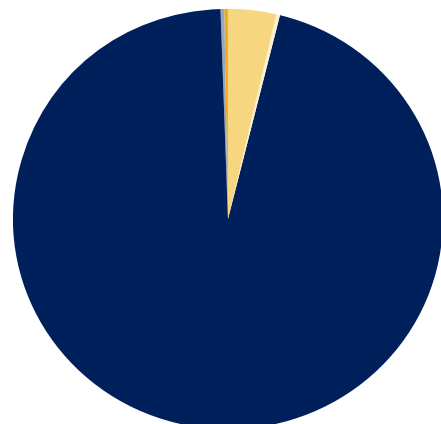
Precipitation: Yearly average of 38 inches
