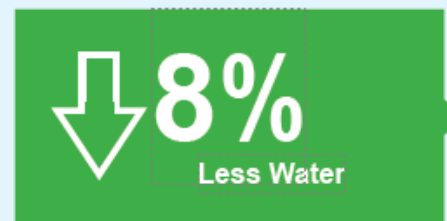

Take Action!

Follow these tips to help you save water and money!



Install Aerators

When you screw an aerator onto a faucet, air is added to the water. You'll use **30% less water** anytime the faucet's on, and you'll hardly notice the difference.



Take Shorter Showers

A typical shower uses 5 gallons of water per minute. Reducing your shower by 1 minute per day can save **150 gallons per month**.



Stop That Leaky Toilet

Even a small leak can waste 10,000 gallons per year! That's equal to **270 loads of laundry!**

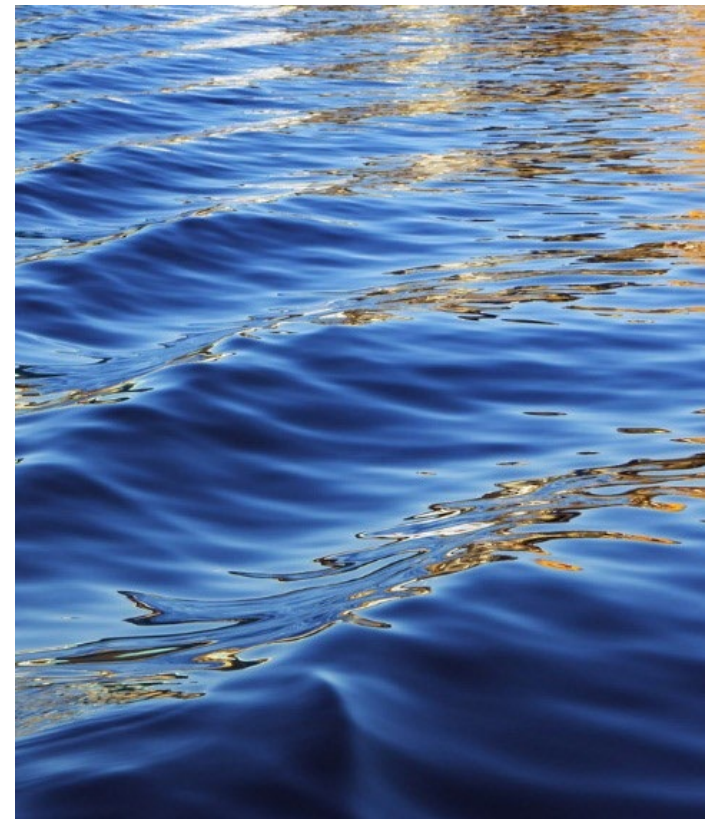

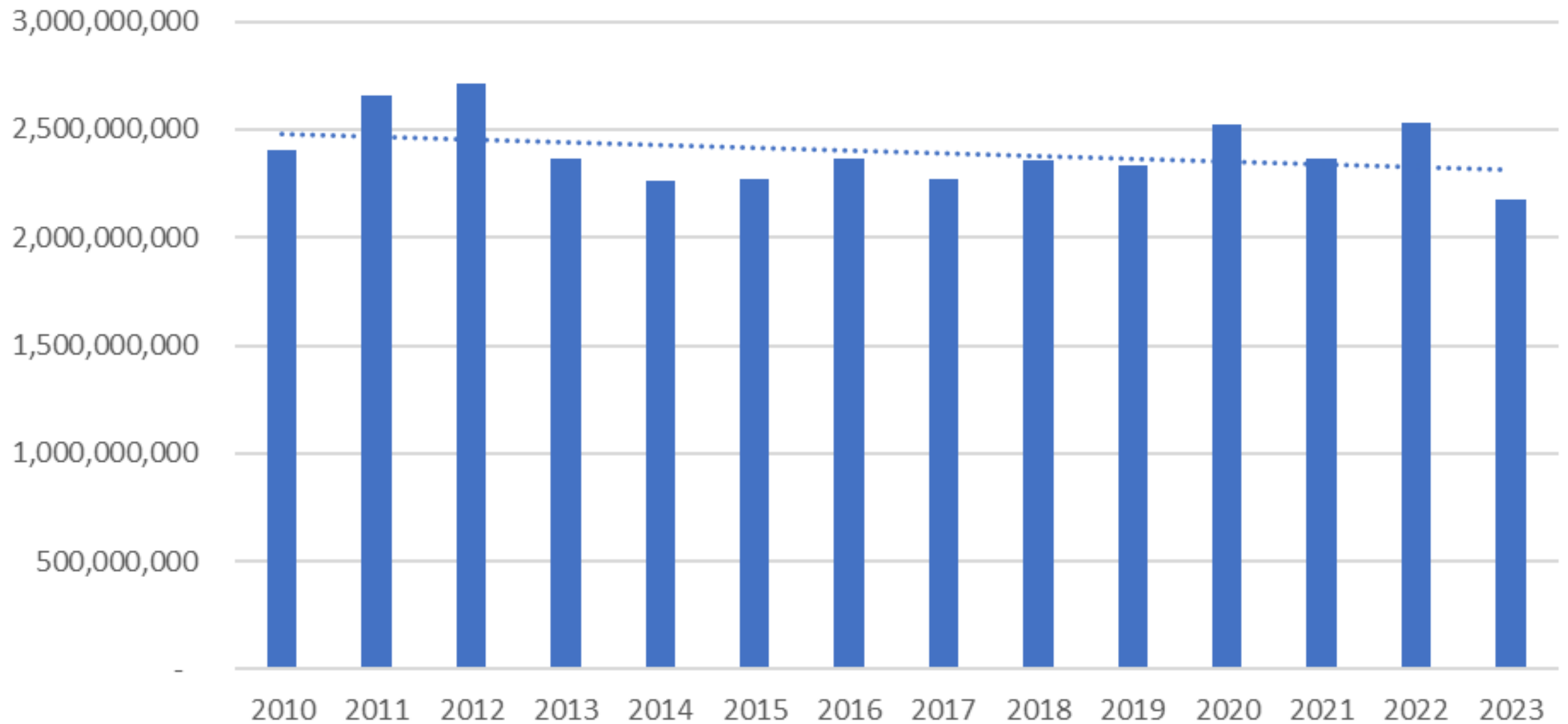

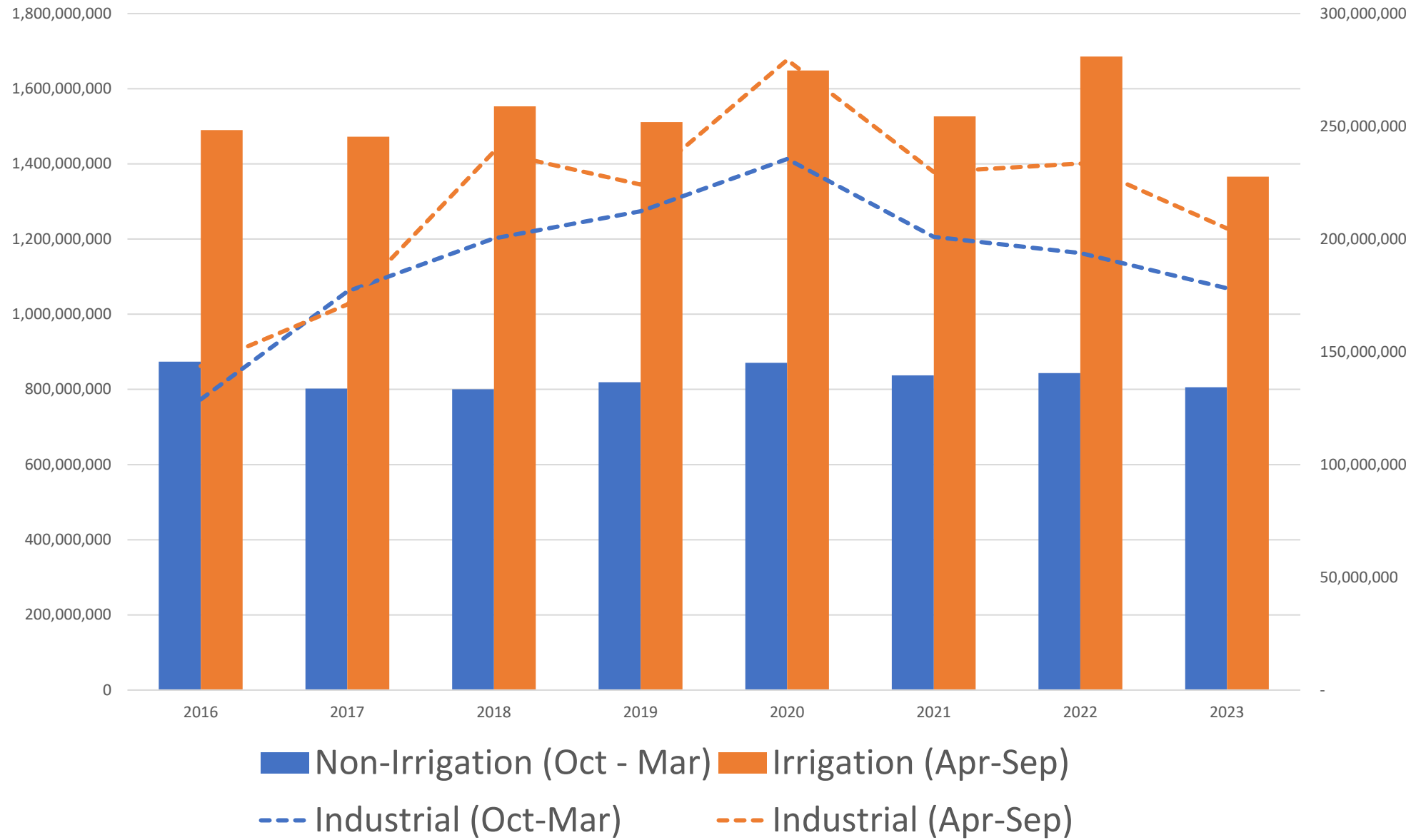

Garden City Water Utility Snapshot

- Water Produced in 2023 – 2.17 Billion Gallons (6665.4 Acre Feet)
- 15 Wells in use
 - 7 – Wells in Sandhills
 - 3 – Wells treated by Reverse Osmosis
 - 2 – Dakota Wells in use.
 - 3 – “Town” Wells.
- 12 Million Gallons of Water Storage
 - 4- 500,000 Gallon Towers
 - 3 Million Ground Reservoir
 - 4 Million Ground Storage Tank
 - 3 Million Ground Storage Tank
- 182 Miles of Water Main
- 9,158 Water Service Connections
- Automated Metering Infrastructure
- 125 Miles of Sewer Collection
- 6 MGD Activated Sludge Treatment Plant
