5. Regional Activities

- a. **RAC Goals & Action Plans Update Recommendations:** At this time the committee members would like to refocus their regional goals to incorporate water conservation and bringing in an alternate source of supply. Much discussion was had on a goal entailing conservation of the Ogallala Aquifer and another goal focusing on an alternate source. There was also the thought of margining both draft goals into one to incorporate both goals.
 - i. Conservation Goal Comments: Should focus on usable supply of water for quality as well as yield, economy, and conservation. Consider terminology along the lines of either sustainable, stabilize, extending, or something that is all encompassing and not extending the problem. As well, it should be noted that water right priority should be mentioned in the goal and that this goal should be realistically achievable by supporting current programs that help conserve today.
 - **ii. Alternate Source of Supply Goal Comments:** It was mentioned that it may be best to merge a conservation goal with this goal as an overall action plan for the UA RAC. It was also mentioned that such as project would be great for the region but the time it may take for water to be available may take tens of years and considerations must be made now to utilize the current resource. The goal is a lofty goal but at this time needs to focus on what can be done by the RAC members now to initiate such a project across the state; or even across multiple states.

 - i. KDHE- Wade Kleven did not have anything to report at this time.
 - **ii. KWO-** Armando noted that the surveys for a possible virtual Governor's Water Conference were still being accepted, the scheduled September KWA meeting has been cancelled, and KWO is still mostly teleworking but operational day to day.
